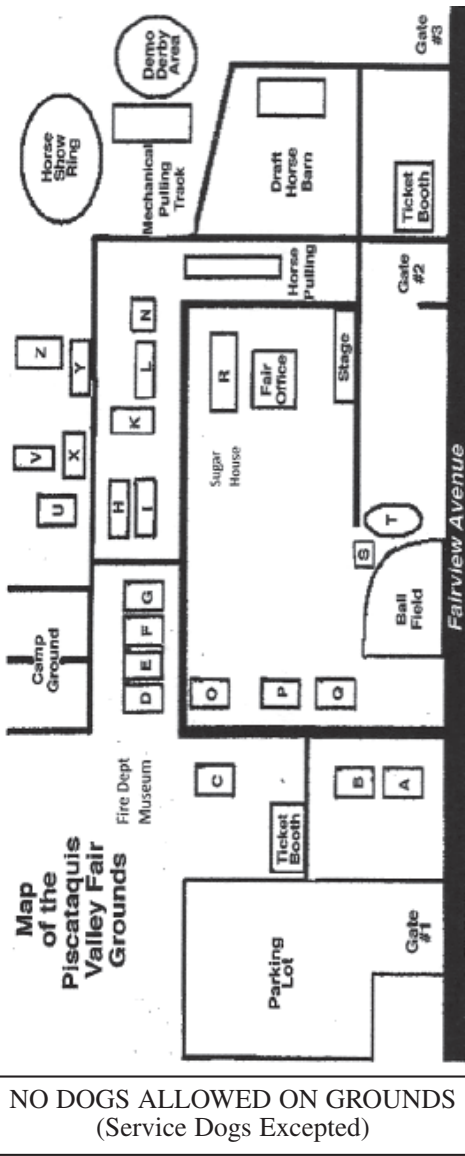


MAP OF FAIRGROUNDS
